



## Book Club Discussion Guide for *The God Protocol: Dragon*

### 1. Initial Thoughts

- What were your first impressions of *The God Protocol: Dragon*? Did anything surprise or immediately captivate you?

- If you could speak to the author, what insights or questions would you ask regarding the book's deeper meanings?
